ROOFING WARRANTY- COLORBOND® ULTRA PREPAINTED STEEL

COLORBOND® Ultra pre-painted steel
COLORBOND® Ultra steel USED IN THE MANUFACTURE OF ROOF SHEETS
WARRANTY TO PERFORATION OF ROOF SHEETS

BlueScope Steel Limited ABN 16 000 011 058 (hereinafter called "BlueScope Steel"), warrants that the COLORBOND® Ultra steel (the "Product") supplied to ROLLFORMER to be fabricated into PROFILE is manufactured from prime material and will have a life prior to perforation by weathering in the natural elements of 10 years from the date of installation, being AUG-2006 at PROJECT-STREET ADDRESS, SUBURB NSW

Furthermore, BlueScope Steel warrants that the exterior paint system of the COLORBOND® steel will not flake or peel (ie delaminate) for a period of 10 years from the date of installation. However, normal weathering which includes natural reduction in paint gloss and a natural colour change of the paint finish is not covered by this warranty.

Warranty is subject to the following terms and conditions:

1. The Product is installed in accordance with manufacturer's published fixing recommendations current at the time of installation.
2. Installed pitch of the roof is equal to or greater than 5 degrees above the horizontal.
3. The roof is fully lined and does not contain exposed eaves or other areas sheltered or unwashed by natural rainfall.
4. All fasteners used for fixing the Product to be in accordance with BlueScope Steel recommendations and comply with Australian Standard AS3566: Class 4 where applicable.
5. The Product has an official COLORBOND® steel brand.
6. All flashings and components fixed to the roof must be either manufactured from COLORBOND® Ultra steel, aluminium, zinc, or other BlueScope Steel approved material in accordance with BlueScope Steel recommendations.
7. The COLORBOND® Ultra steel paint finish must not be scratched, abraded, or damaged in any way, or coated with an incompatible material.
8. Perforations partly or wholly due to the following causes are not covered by this warranty:
 - (a) Mechanical, chemical, corrosion or other damage sustained during transport, handling, storage, erection or subsequent to erection.
 - (b) Attack from chemical agents, fumes, liquids or solids other than direct rain falling onto the product under warranty.
 - (c) Contact with soils, ashes, fertilizers or other moisture retaining substances.
 - (d) Areas in metallic contact with lead or copper or subject to the run-off from copper flashings and pipes.
 - (e) Failure to remove debris and/or failure to provide free drainage of water including internal condensation from all surfaces of the Product.
 - (f) Deterioration of the Product caused by contact with green or wet timber or treated timber.
 - (g) Installations subject to unusually corrosive environments at any time in the future.
 - (h) Storm and tempest or other acts of God.

Remedies for Breach of Warranty

This Warranty excludes all other warranties, representations, conditions, offers, promises or assurances ("Terms"), whether expressed or implied, except to the extent that such Terms cannot by virtue of law be excluded.

Subject to the above, if the Product suffers corrosion to perforation, or where a condition or warranty is implied into this Warranty by law that cannot be excluded, BlueScope Steel's liability is limited to one of the following, at its option:

- (a) repair of the affected part of the Product or payment of the cost of having the affected part of the Product repaired, or
- (b) supply sufficient quantity of replacement Product or equivalent product to replace the affected part of the Product, or
- (c) refund to the purchaser of the Product the cost of the original purchase price of the affected part of the Product (provided adequate proof of purchase is provided).

The aggregate liability of BlueScope Steel is the purchase price of the Product at the time of installation. BlueScope Steel will not be liable for any consequential loss or damage, howsoever arising, whether or not it was aware of the possibility of such loss or damage.

BlueScope Steel extends this warranty solely to the manufacturer.

BlueScope Steel reserve the right to inspect a building prior to issuing of the warranty.
